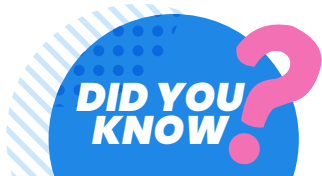

Hello collectors, art lovers, children young and old, and of course the GPK community which has greatly supported me since my first creations.

Usually, I remain discreet about who I am, I prefer to express myself with my little colored pens! It's not a strategy, it's just the way I am. Thanks to the designer of ALMANAC (Jeremiah Scott, Richard Rios) for inviting me, I will try to let you enter into my life a little more.

## *Little short story...*

I started at 6 years old. This year 2021, in an old drawing pouch, I found two Explorin Norman (Mathieu le Degueu) made around my sixth birthday...Unbelievable, I had forgotten how much these little Crados influenced me. I remember my first Les Crados collection, I was passionate and ready for everyone to buy me new cards. I remember I would run away from my school at recess to buy Les Crados pouches at a nearby store, stole money from my parents, and traded my toys at school. At 40 now, I tell myself what madness. Of course my entire collection is missing now and I have no idea where it has gone.

Eventually, at the age of 17, I started collecting again. It was at a garage sale I caught a glimpse of a similar card box only the banner was different... Garbage Pail Kids. The internet has helped me understand that this little French filthy world is nothing compared to the GPK world! Without knowing at the time it turns out these lots contained a lot of cards from series 1 and 2! A few years later my collection was on hiatus and I had left France to settle in Canada (Montreal, Quebec). There I started a family, had a daughter, and came into my profession as an architect while still continuing to develop my art. Over the years I have many exhibitions and collaborations to my credit although this activity is secondary to my family and Career. Once again I put my nose into the GPKs because Canada is close to the USA and that makes buying a lot easier. I ended up immersing myself in the North American culture which allowed me to deeply understand those who love these little cards and also understand who I am.

In 2020 I entered this community through social media and started to complete my collection again. I naturally tried a first card sketch, I remember it was He-Man. I shared that first card





on GPK Marketplace and it sold quickly. Shortly after came my first commission, another He-Man. Since then the orders have been steady throughout the last two years.

Initially I ignorantly placed the official GPK banner at the top of my cards... groups. Luckily, a great official artist contacted me to tell me 3 things:

First, stop putting the official banners on your drawings, and secondly, Submit your work to TOPPS. Lastly he said "Be patient and eventually you will be contacted to join the group of official TOPPS artists!

I want to thank Rory for being one of my first references in the world of GPK Artist, He's more than a TOPPS artist, he's an artist beyond GPK and his is both discreet and generous.

Soon following I applied with the few card visuals I had made without the official banners ... I seem to remember having sent 2 emails, one in April, and another in May of 2020.

Timing was maybe perfect because later in May I received my first email from Topps asking if I would be interested in contributing art for GPK 35th Untold Stories so of course I said YES! For that set I contributed 40 sketch cards and that's how it all started! I was so proud to be able to officially offer my art to collectors and so proud that my lines and my colors resonate in this world.

Fast forward to today and I have had the chance to participate in 8 GPK sets, 1 UGLY STICKERS set and I am quietly entering the world of WACKY PACKAGES. Everything is connected.

You're going to laugh at me, but I don't even collect sketch cards. I only have a few unofficial maps of my favorite character Explorin Norman. My GPK collection seems beautiful to me and is almost complete. I collect sketch cards through the community. Knowing these little bits of me are loved in your homes and in your collections is most important so take care of them please! These days there are too many variations for my taste, I collect the basic sets so that I have all the new creations of our current favorite big artists! Thanks Brent, David and Joe. And also all those who gave birth to the GPK!

I thank all the collectors who support me. Some that I have known since my first steps in this environment are still there, faithful and always in demand of my drawings. I'm proud they never tire of it! Thank you : David, Aviel, Danny, Jason, Steven, Jeff, Arnaud, Tiffany, Adam D. and Adam G... I can't name them all but I'm thinking of them right now.

I am always trying to keep things fresh by coming up with new ways to experiment on paper, skateboard, discs and more supports. I like to surprise, think outside the box, and push my limits.

Currently I am working on an incredible project, which will take a lot of my time. My mission is to draw on a Les Crados album. The Album is empty, with no cards, and I have to draw the 162 characters. It's a huge undertaking but I will continue to work through it when time permits. As most of you may know, my main job is an architect and my days are busy!

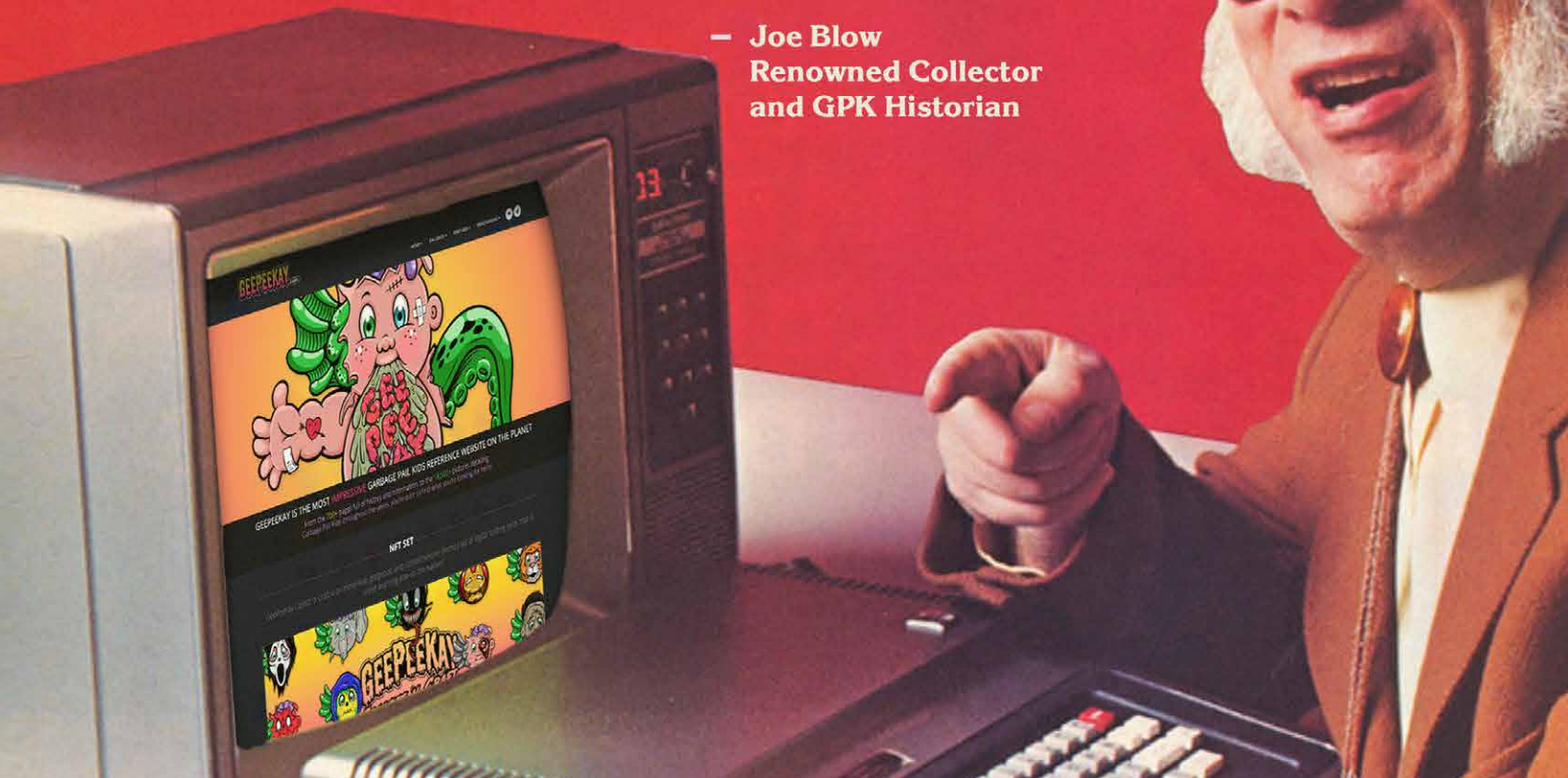

## ADAM AKA BOB SLYDEL



### WHAT'S YOUR BEST CHILDHOOD MEMORY OF GPK AS A KID?

This is more of a general memory than something specific. Most of what I remember about GPK was towards the end in 1987 and 1988. I was 8 years old. I remember scrounging up a dollar or two and riding my bike to the gas station with my friends. The gas station where we would buy GPK was probably 4 miles away and it was on a highway. (Times were much different back then. Kids don't do that stuff now). We would buy a couple packs of GPK, a bunch of jolly ranchers or a fruit pie and a pop. We'd start riding back and stop at a pond that was along the road and open our GPK and eat our snacks. I distinctly remember buying OS10 packs with Varicose Wayne on the wrapper. Of course, I would keep all my GPK in a shoe box at home (wrapped in rubber bands) and my friends and I would trade them on the bus ride to school.

### WHAT GOT YOU BACK INTO COLLECTING?

In 1999 I was in the Air Force in Omaha, Nebraska. For some reason I decided to search for 'Garbage Pail Kids' on eBay. There wasn't a ton of GPK on eBay back in those days. I found a guy with a binder of OS2-15 who lived pretty close to me. I went and met him in a grocery store parking lot and I bought the binder for \$300. I didn't have a lot of time or money in those days so I was content just having a binder of GPK to look at. Once I graduated college in 2003 and got a real job, I started collecting GPK again full time. The OS2-15 sets I bought in 1999 are still in my personal collection.

### BEING THE ADMIN OF THE DOND PAGE YOU ARE KNOWN FOR BIG DEALS. WHAT'S THE BIGGEST OR MOST UNIQUE DEAL YOU'VE BEEN A PART OF EITHER SELLING OR BUYING?

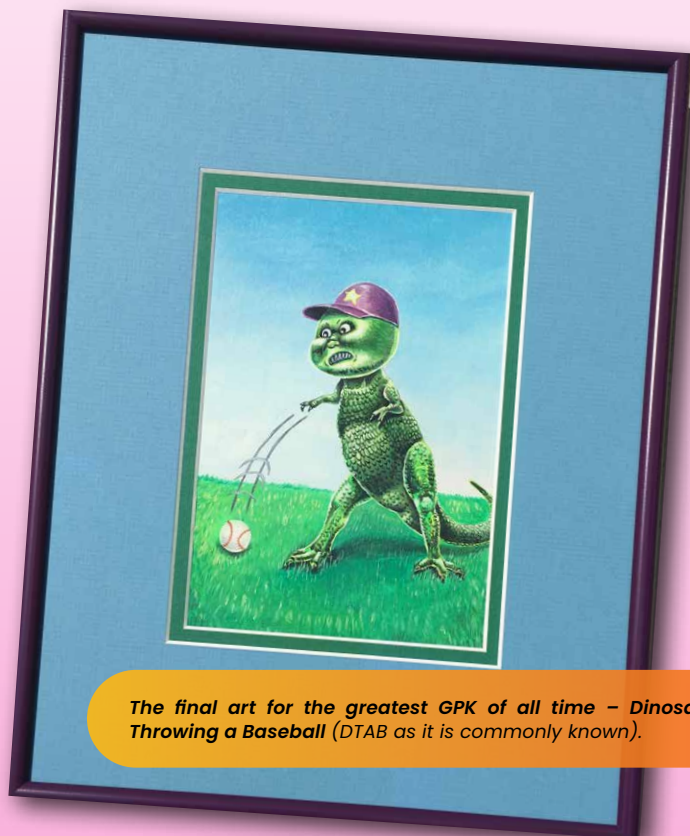
One of the most unique deals that I can remember was selling the Bill Ding final art to a collector in the UK in January 2018. This deal was unique because he paid me in Bitcoin. I'm not sure if this was the first ever GPK trade in crypto currency, but I'm confident to say it was probably the first GPK final art deal in Crypto. I sold Bill Ding for 0.51829254 Bitcoin which at the time was worth approximately \$7,100. If I had kept that Bitcoin it would be worth \$24,332 today!

### WHAT ARE YOU CURRENTLY COLLECTING?

Currently I am collecting stuff from all three Chrome releases. I am working on Chrome 1 & 2 gold sets. Next I want to start working on Chrome 3 black, orange and gold sets.

### WHAT WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE FOR THE FUTURE OF THE HOBBY OR THE COMMUNITY?

I miss the carefree days of the Underground, there was a much larger sense of community. Everyone got along and helped each other out. We've migrated to Facebook and with that came the drama. I wish people would just collect what they like, mind their own business and have fun with the hobby.

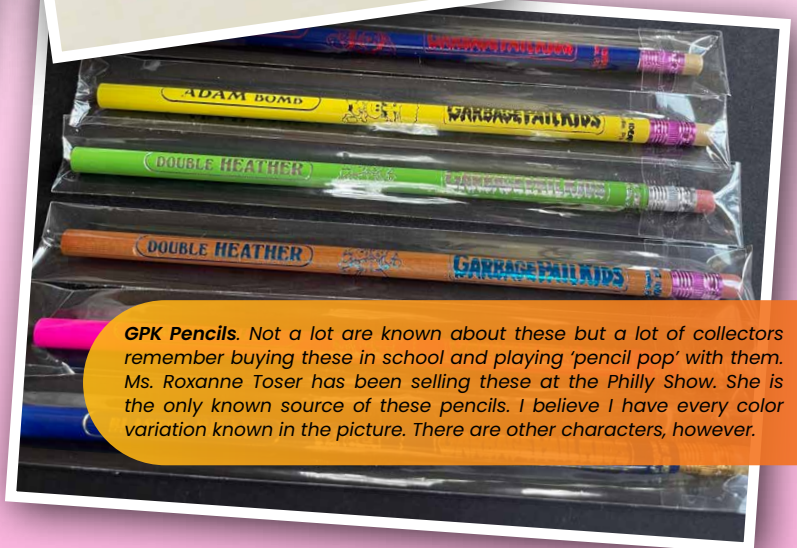

It all worked out though. This was the last piece I needed to complete a full run of OS1-OS16 final art.



**Unpublished rejected OS16 final art by John Pound.** The story goes that when Topps scrapped OS16, they destroyed all the OS16 final art. John Pound had this one because it was rejected and sent back to him. So this is the only OS16 final art known to exist.



**Adam Bomb OS1 8a Award Back PSA 10 Gem Mint.** Signed on the front by John Pound and on the back by Tom Bunk. I purchased this card raw on eBay with the signatures. I sent it to PSA. This was the first card I ever had graded at PSA. I was hoping for an 8 or a 9. When PSA called me and told me it was a 10, I was ecstatic.



**GPK Pencils.** Not a lot are known about these but a lot of collectors remember buying these in school and playing 'pencil pop' with them. Ms. Roxanne Toser has been selling these at the Philly Show. She is the only known source of these pencils. I believe I have every color variation known in the picture. There are other characters, however.

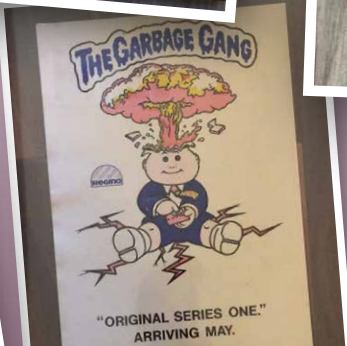

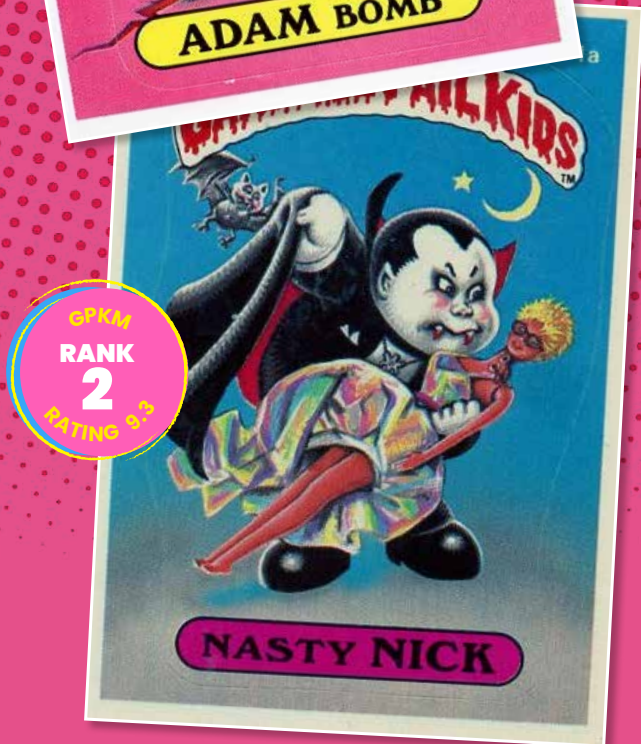

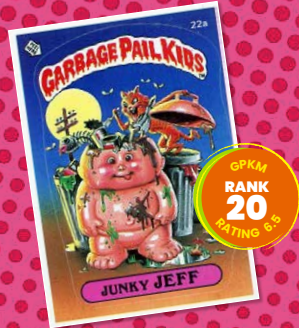

# 100K OBSERVATIONS

## Hi GPK Community!

The Sapphire Tracking team has hit a couple huge milestones over the last few weeks: 3,000+ boxes and 100,000+ cards tracked. Given those milestones, we've put together a Sapphire summary, in case reading spreadsheets isn't your thing...

### PROJECT STATS

- **442 breaks**, starting in December 2020
- **3,180 boxes** tracked
- **101,760 cards**
- **6,375 hits tracked**
- **10,244 total hits** known when combining tracking data+external sources (33.42% of total parallels)
- Estimated **20% of all produced cards** seen in breaks

### CARD STATS

- **98 padparadschas** are known/have been seen, 68 remain
- Missing cards/haven't been seen anywhere: 10 reds, 65a orange, 18a gold, 22 teals
- Highly unlikely the 22 missing teals exist
- 6 characters have had **all reds** pulled (1a, 6a, 9b, 40b, 43b, 55a), 17 have just 1 remaining
- 1 character has had **all purples** pulled (26a), 2 have just 1 remaining (25a, 41a)
- The **fewest parallels** pulled: 7a

- The **most parallels** pulled: 26a

- **Top base card:** 27a

- **Lowest base card:** 42b, but rotates between single print cards

- **Rosegold/Pink** appears to be limited 5 cards each, none above 50 a/b



### BOX STATS

- Teal/Green is the **top box combination** for hits (761 boxes/24.5%)
- Teal/Orange is next (589/18.9%)
- All other combinations are 7% or lower in seen boxes
- Teal/Green/Green is the only combination to be seen once
- We've seen two instances with **packs containing 2 hits**:
  - Caleb 5/15, box 2, pack 1
  - Scott 11/23, box 7, pack 8
- 2,006 boxes have contained **2 hits** (63%)
- 522 boxes have had 3 hits, with 504 having just 1 (16%)
- 74 boxes (2.3%) have had **no hits**, 73 boxes have had 4 (2.29%)

### BREAKER STATS (100+ BOXES TRACKED)

- **33 different breakers**, ranging from 8 single/personal box breaks to 606 boxes (SPK)
- Breakers have pulled 39 padparadschas
- SPK has pulled **11 padparadschas** (1.8% of his boxes)
- Jheremie leads the **red rate**, with 22 pulled 295 boxes (7.5%)
- Leonidas' red rate is just behind with 19 in 274 (6.9%), he also leads in **gold rate** (18%)
- Larry's 13% rate leads **purples** pulled, with Scott/Jheremie at 12%. Of 442 breaks, only 12 times has a **parallel rainbow** been pulled

**Note:** Going forward, we will no longer track base cards. With the 100k milestone, we don't expect anything to change. We know there are 34 'double print' cards based on data.

# SAPPHIRE Q&A

## **FOUR SAPPHIRE CASES SUDDENLY APPEAR.**

It's been almost a year since Garbage Pail Kids Sapphire was released, and only now have we seen and opened a sealed case. Why are these Cases of boxes so elusive, and why didn't we see any cases of boxes prior? According to many sources sapphire boxes are shipped loose from the manufacturer / distributor. With 15,000-17,000 boxes in production, and 10 inside a case you would think there would have been 1500-1700 cases; however we've only seen four. All from the same source.

### **So where did it come from?**

The cases boxes that we have seen all came from the original sale to the Montgomery club.

### **Why haven't we seen them with all the other box sales?**

We don't actually know why, and opening a case has not provided any additional information on why Topps would not want to sell them in cases. My personal assumption is that either Topps knew that single boxes are more likely to get opened than cases, or there was a collation issue that we can't determine from the data in a single case.

### **What did we learn from the case break?**

Not much at all. There was even a missing parallel card (19 of 20). The case break is not distinguishable from a 10 random box break.

### **What is the value of a BBCE Wrapped Sapphire case?**

This is a tough one. We know there are 3 left from this batch, and possibly others out there. I personally don't think there are many still remaining. If a Sapphire box is valued at \$650, there has to be a premium for a sealed case due to its rarity. If \$6,500 is the cost/value of the ten boxes inside the case, it would be fair to say \$8,500-\$10,000 is a good market value. The final case is currently up for sale on eBay for \$14,995.

## **THE NEW SAPPHIRE PARALLEL COLOR (PINK/ROSE GOLD)**

On August 30th, a seven month backlog of Missing Parallel card claims were fulfilled with an unnumbered "refractor" pinkish sapphire-like card. These were unnumbered, but by tracking original recipients from Topps; we were able to identify that 3 sheets of 100 cards with characters 1a-50b were printed and distributed. There were 2 more batches of shipments after which, bringing the total assumed population to 5 per card and 500 cards total. There are a lot of mysteries here, many of which we will never know the answer to.

### **Is this a TRUE sapphire card?**

Well the back of the card is dated 2020, so we can assume Topps would like to consider this a Sapphire Parallel card. It's also a different color than any of the parallels in the series.

It is slightly thinner than a Sapphire parallel and slightly thicker than a Sapphire base card.

The graphics are not as crisp and detailed as sapphire cards.

It is not numbered, with just a REFRACTOR stamp on the back (with the exception of Checklist cards)

With all that in mind, I think it's up in the air as to if these cards should be considered part of the sapphire group of parallel cards.

### **What are the values of these cards?**

We have seen Pink/Rose Gold cards sell for around \$250-\$450 a piece, with a premium on the more popular characters. I would assume once Topps ends the missing hit program, that we will see a final production of 5 to 10 per card and a final value of slightly over a purple parallel.

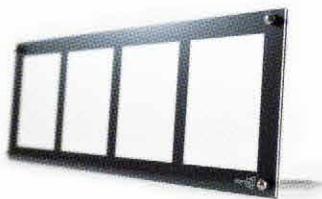
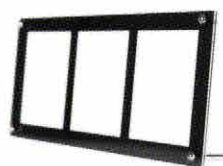
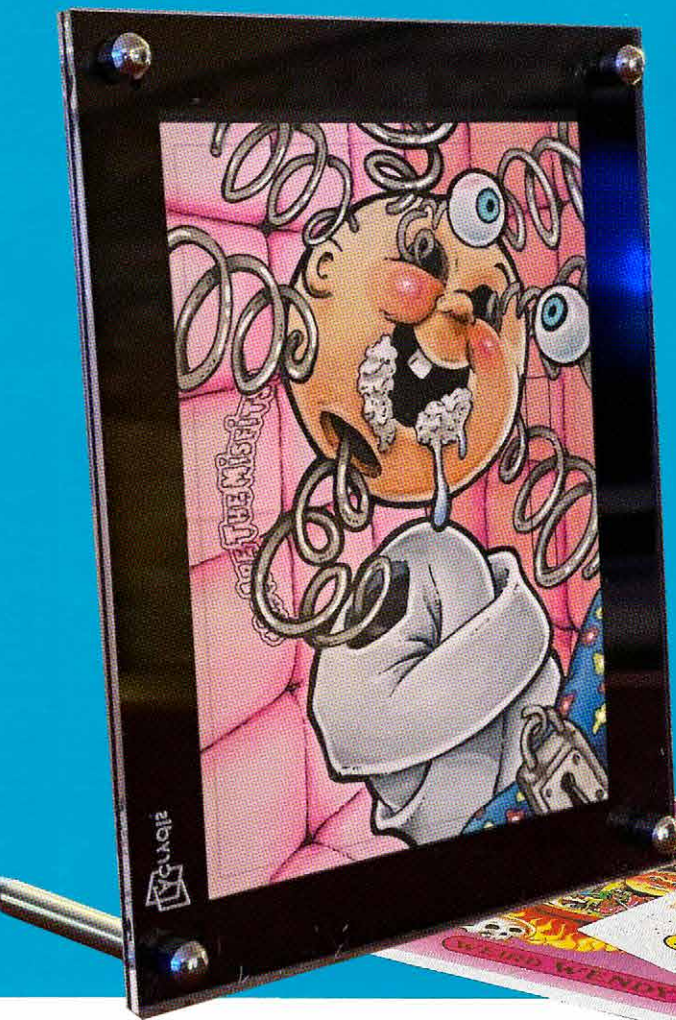
