



HOW DID YOU START DRAWING FOR TOPPS?

I would say the first step was getting invited to the GPK groups, which helped me connect with artists and collectors. Many liked the art I was putting out and I started to receive commissions. A couple artists I chatted with online explained to me how to submit my artwork to Topps. I want to say Thank You to Dan B. Webster and Kelly Greider for pointing me in the right direction, I appreciate you fellas. I then submitted my artwork in the summer of 2017 to Colin Walton. He was the art director at Topps during that time. A couple months later I received an email from him inviting me to draw sketch cards for "Garbage Pail Kids Classic" and "Wacky Packages Old School 6" on demand sets. Big shout out to Colin Walton for giving me the opportunity! He made my dream come true to be an official GPK artist.

HOW DID YOU GET BACK INTO COLLECTING?

In 2010 I ran into some Garbage Pail Kids on eBay. The card art and names immediately brought back childhood memories. I searched for a while before I picked up a 1985 Adam Bomb for only \$20. When it showed up I couldn't believe you could still buy the cards in new condition and cheap! Then I heard about Garbage Pail Kids Flashback. I found some packs at Target and been hooked ever since.

ANY MEMORY YOU HAVE FROM WHEN YOU ORIGINALLY COLLECTED?

Ever since I was a young kid in the late '80s and '90s, I've always been into collectibles. I collected action figures, video games, and trading cards. I was big on TMNT figures, Nintendo gaming and I had a binder with a small collection of Marvel cards. I didn't have any GPKs, but my older brother had sets of original series. I can still remember going through his OS3 cards trying to put the Mugged Marcus puzzle together.





GPK RELATED STORY YOU WOULD LIKE TO TELL? COULD BE ABOUT YOUR

FAVORITE CHARACTER OR ANYTHING YOU WANT TO SAY ABOUT THE STATE OF THE HOBBY IN GENERAL?

My favorite Garbage Pail Kid is New Wave Dave. He's my namesake character and I can relate to him. I once painted him over ten feet tall using only spray cans. This was the biggest I ever painted a GPK and it turned out pretty good. It was on the side of an art building "The Art Movement" in Los Angeles California. Good Times

The hobby has changed a lot in the last few years. Some say it's good, some say its bad. I'm going to keep on collecting.

MOST CHALLENGING OR INTERESTING COMMISSION YOU'VE EVER DONE?

The most challenging commission I've done was not too long ago, for a friend and fellow collector "Chuy Luna". He requested 3 IDW Garbage Pail Kids comics puzzle style. That made it challenging since they all had to connect! His main request was he wanted original GPK Artist John Pound center of the books surrounded by Garbage Pail Kids. He let me choose the characters and I ended up painting 17 GPKs on it. Had a good time with that one even though it was tough to complete.

FAVORITE GPK MEMORY FROM YOUR CHILDHOOD?

My favorite memories come from seeing the new releases for the first time. Just getting a glimpse of the new packs or cards was a rush. I remember OS4 to OS5 taking an eternity to happen. It probably only took a few months, but to a kid, that is forever. I remember finding a card back of a Terri Cloth puzzle piece on the ground one day. The sticker on the front had been peeled, but I knew that what I was holding in my hand came from OS5. I couldn't find OS5 anywhere yet. Trips to the store yielded nothing but OS4 packs for a few weeks. However, I kept that single puzzle piece and speculated on what the whole image would look like. Seeing the OS5 black packs for the first time was awesome, and to this day the OS5 packs are the coolest looking to me and Terri Cloth is my favorite OS5.



FAVORITE GPK MEMORY AS AN ADULT?

Forming GPK Underground is my favorite memory. The GPK community before Facebook was something special. I made some long-lasting memories, and more importantly, long-lasting friendships. In the forum format, you could really get to know people and their personalities. Facebook is super easy and convenient to use, but posting something is buried in minutes, it's the equivalent of running into a random person wearing a GPK shirt at the grocery store...a single serving conversation that is forgotten almost immediately. I'm thankful for the time we had. So many good times, from the epic threads to the in-person meet-ups. The UG community will always be my favorite GPK memory overall.

WHAT GOT YOU OUT OF GPK COLLECTING WHEN YOU WERE YOUNG?

It was a few things. First, the GPK Movie was an absolute shit pile. After seeing that movie in the theater, it damn near killed my GPK spirit. Then OS10 came out and they changed the style of the cards. So now the cards sucked too. Also, the NES was starting to gain favor in my life and quickly took over as my #1 hobby. So eventually, I just took all of the GPK I had and stuck them to things. I quit GPK cold turkey and forgot about them until around 2002.

WHY DID YOU GET BACK INTO COLLECTING GPK?

Around 2002 GPK popped back into my head. I think I was having a conversation with someone about 80's toys or something. I immediately went to eBay and started looking at sets. I looked up other information on GPK and found WGPKR and Barron Aaron's reference sites. Shortly after I bought all of the cards and the variations. The nostalgia was ignited, and I was fully back into GPK again. Then the ANS was announced in 2003 and it was off to the races. I got involved in the community and bought GPK when I could. I didn't make much money and I was going to college back then, so it was tough to fit it in. Seeing Topps sell all of the art when I didn't have funds was really hard. I had to run up credit card debt when a piece I needed came up for sale.

Collector Spotlight CORST PIERCE

DO YOU STILL COLLECT?

Very minimally. The stuff that Topps releases now doesn't appeal to me at all. I'm not interested in the themed sets with tons of low-quality art/concepts. I lived through that once with the ANS. Also, I'm not keen on buying OS1 and OS2 over and over again. I quit buying new GPK the first time Topps started re-releasing the stuff we've already bought, with the Flashback releases. I'm always on the lookout to upgrade my OS art collection though. There are a few upgrades I could make.

WHAT WAS THE TOUGHEST ACQUISITION TO YOUR COLLECTION?

There were a few tough adds, items that I had to wait years to acquire. The toughest was the reacquisition of final art for ANS4 Hollow Wayne. I was the original owner of the piece. I traded it straight up to get the OS6 Dyna Mike final art. After the trade, I made it a goal to get it back in my collection. It took me almost 9 years to get it back, but it happened in 2017. Plus, to make the deal happen, I had to fly to Texas and take delivery of the piece in person. It was a fun trip.

WHAT WAS THE STRANGEST THING YOU SAW ON THE UG?

It's hard to choose one specific thing. We had a lot of weird stuff happen. One of the things that sticks out is the ANS7 B2 Fiasco. Topps didn't insert the B2 cards into the bonus boxes as they should have. So, it took the GPKUG community to get them to do a reprint. Jon Mayr was the ringleader in bugging Topps to get this done. Many people contributed though. I think we bothered them so much, Topps decided to just give in, reprint the card and do a redemption program. Jon then memorialized the occasion by getting Mark Pingitore and Luis Diaz to collaborate on a 5X7 watercolor sketch and to dual autograph the reprinted cards. I was able to acquire an original print ANS7 B2. You can tell the difference between the original print and 2nd print by the lighter color on the back of the card. The original print B2 will match the other bonus cards from the set. The 2nd print is slightly darker.





We all know that Adam and Nick are always hot commodities, but more and more we are starting to see other singles starting to catch fire in the markets for various different reasons. In this feature we will discuss the cards that are currently burning holes in our pockets that aren't la or 8a.



Slasher Asher/Claude Flesh — It has become a nightmare snatching up this 15th Series card. A huge surge in recent popularity has caused a rush on near mint to mint and well centered Slashers. It's getting so HORRORIfic that even rough condition Slashers are getting snatched up. People are especially looking out for the Die-Cuts.



Mike Tyson GPK – We've seen steady value in both the 30th anniversary and the We Hate the 90s of the Tyson cards. No doubt this is a fun card to have but will it obtain the heights of Jumpin' Jordan?



Hacked Hogan/Russel Mania – Are you eating your vitamins little Hulkamaniacs?! Yeah brother!!! This ANS 6 card will absolutely pile drive you and put you down for a 10 count. Little Hulkster has us feeling like it's Wrestlemania III all over again.



Jumpin' Jordan/Mad Michael - This card is still hot but has cooled considerably, reaching as high as \$150-175 for a Jumpin' Jordan, they are now becoming available for 25-50% of their peak value. Will this card continue to cool off or is it leveling off at a reasonable price?



Red Sapphire Parallels - When I say these are hot, I mean RED HOT! These short printed #/5 beauties were undervalued for their rarity for some time, but the value has come screaming back. With no Pads available at a obtainable price, these Reds have become center pieces for rainbow and character collectors in general alike.



Late Original Series Sets (12,13,14,15) – due to the larger number of people collecting GPK in the last couple years there has been an influx of collectors looking to grab a complete set of Original Series 1–15, due to the low print runs on these later series its made quite a few of them extremely pricey. But for the hardcore GPK collectors it's a must have!



Trump Time – Each time I think these will finally cool off the prices surge again, it's not as hot as it was a year ago but the prices sure haven't come down. This is still a well sought after card that sells quickly. This has been and appears to remain the premier Trump card to own.



2019 WWE GPK set - Do you smell what the Rock is cooking, do you know what Austin 3:16 says?! It says it doesn't matter what you think! These sets are getting crazy hard to find and are insanely popular due to the characters that they feature. Good luck laying the smack down and securing one!



Semi Colin – Colin may not have a number but people sure are putting up big numbers to own one! This card has quadrupled in value over the past couple years and you are going to have to shell out in the neighborhood of \$500 plus to land this prized and infamous king of the error cards.



Adam Boom/Blasted Billy II – No doubt that the only other Adam card in the Original Series was always beloved, but due to being printed near the height of GPK and somewhat at the beginning of the decline made this a readily available card. Slowly the inventory has been drying up. Good opportunities still exist so it's another good value, potential reward down the road as they continue to sell.
